Library Advocacy Day

Adair County Public Library Director Jami Livingston attended Library Advocacy Day on Tuesday February 26, 2019 in Jefferson City, Missouri. Every year Missouri Library Association hosts this day for library staff and advocates from across the state. The group met at the James C. Kirkpatrick State Information Center. The event opened with remarks from Secretary of State Jay Ashcroft. State Librarian Robin Westphal spoke to the group along with April Roy, past president of the Missouri Library Association. After lunch, the library supporters headed to the State Capitol.

Livingston met with District 4 State Representative Greg Sharpe to speak about libraries and the importance of continued financial support of libraries. Livingston along with Little Dixie Regional Libraries' Director Rachael Grime met with District 18 Senator Cindy O'Laughlin in her office to discuss how people depend on their local libraries for many different things.



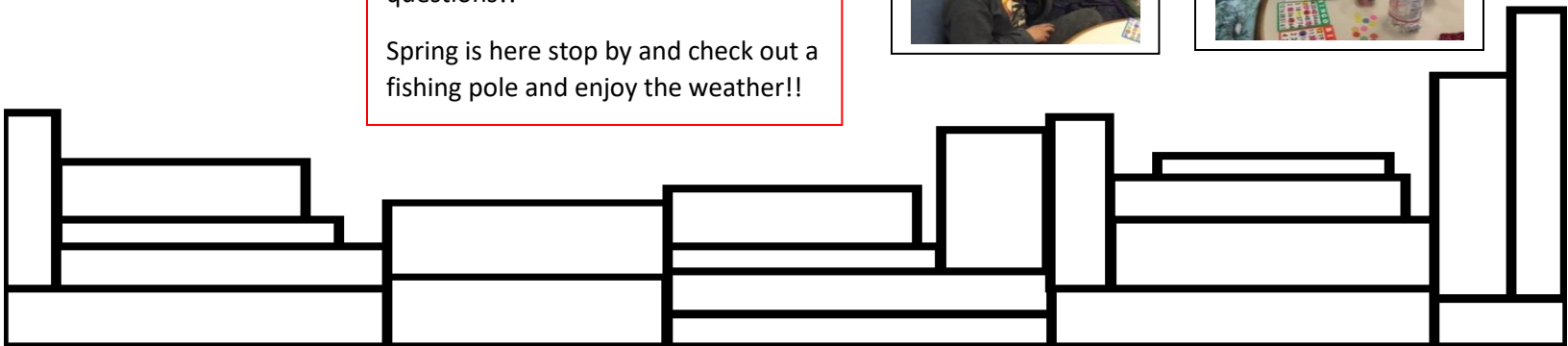
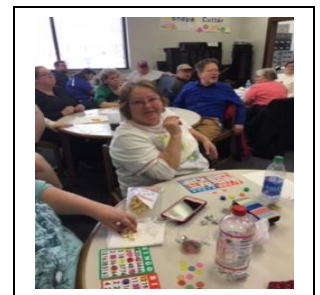
