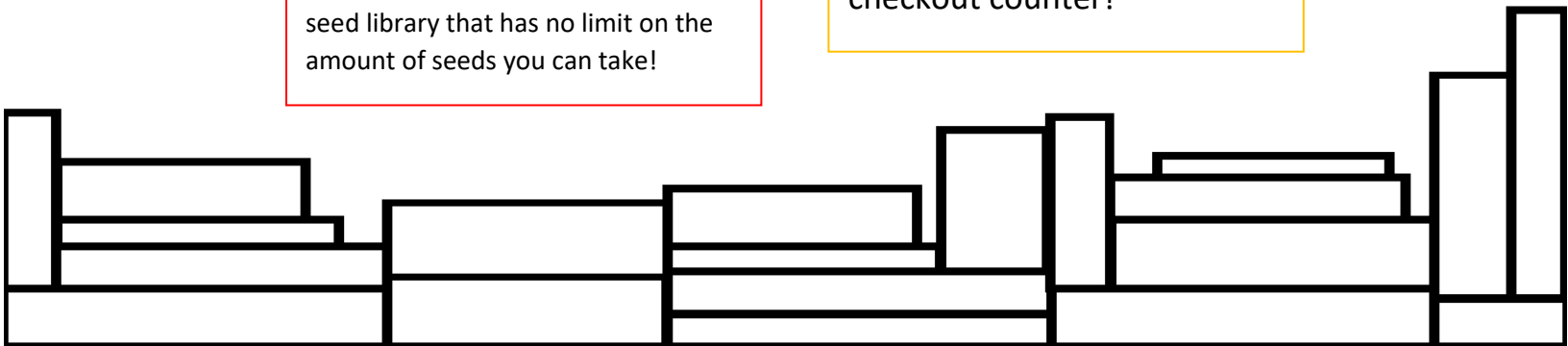
Pet Contest

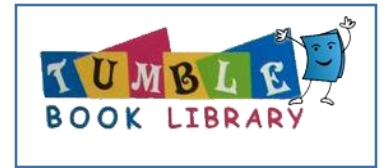

Teen Times

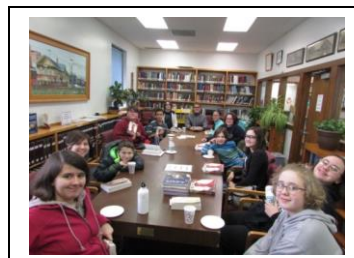
Teen Book Club

Magic the Gathering Night

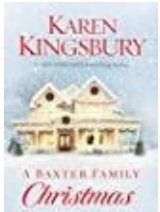

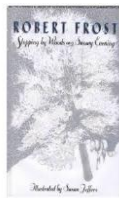

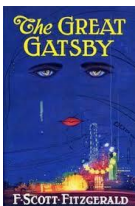
