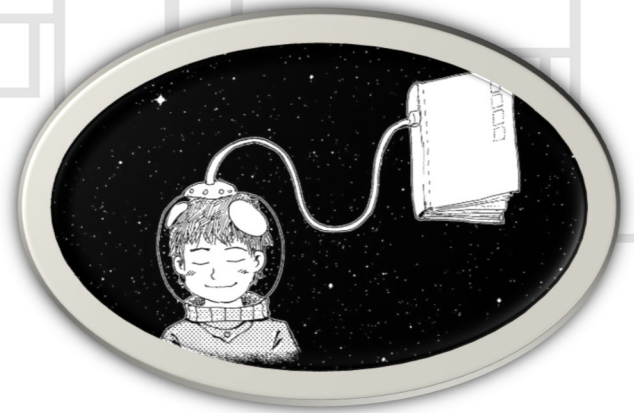
New Furniture

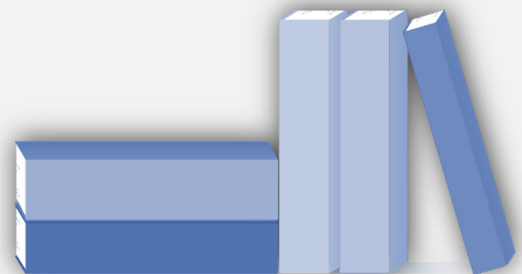
