- *Honor requests from the Director and Children's Librarian*



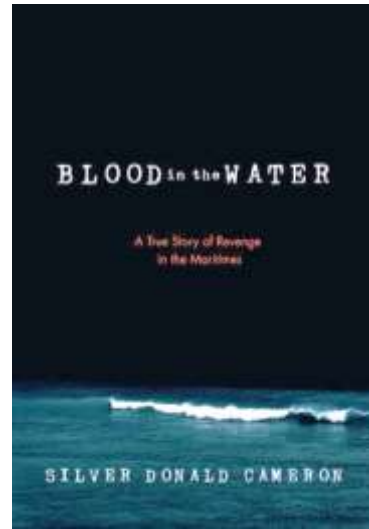
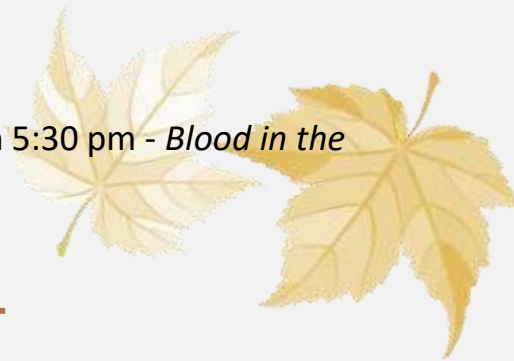
