D&D with us from Home

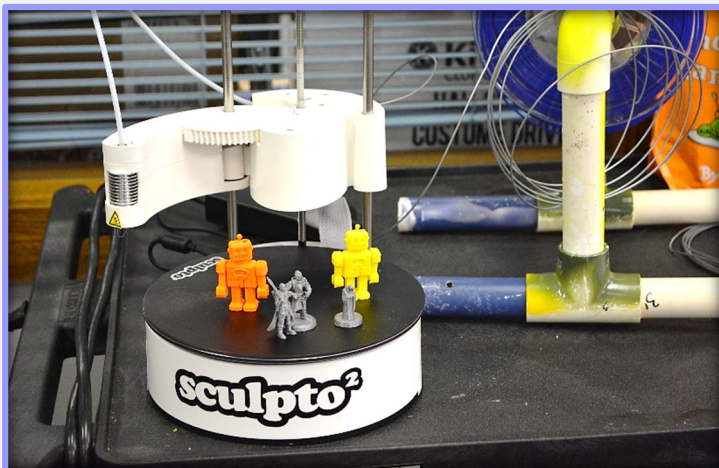

Curbside Print and Copy

We are still offering curbside print and copy services. You can print from your phone to our wireless printer or email your documents to acpl@adairco.org and we will bring them out to you. We can also copy and scan documents for you using our copier. Prints are 25¢/page for black and white or 50¢/page for color. Copies are 10¢/page for black and white or 25¢/page for color. Scanning a document to your email is free. Laminating is also available (please call 20 minutes ahead.)
