DIY Kaleidoscope

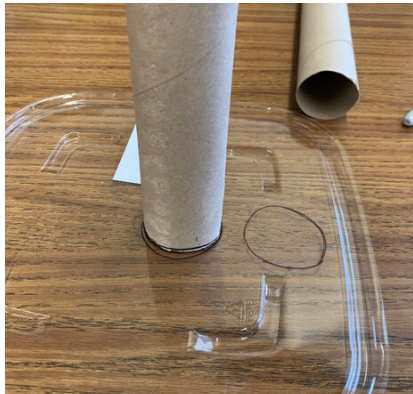
MATERIALS:

- Cardboard tube
- Plastic sheet, like from a fruit or cookie package
- Reflective paper (I used tinfoil)
- Beads
- Card stock
- Scissors
- Hot glue

Optional: construction paper, markers, washi tape, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace the cardboard tube twice on your plastic sheet. Cut out, and trim one down to fit inside the cardboard tube. Hot glue inside, approximately $1/4''$ - $1/2''$ from edge.



2. Allow hot glue to cool completely. Pour beads into shallow end of tube, and hot glue second plastic circle to edge. Be careful not to glue your beads down!



3. Measure the depth of the cardboard tube, and cut out a piece of card stock that long. Fold into a triangle that will fit inside your plastic tube, and wrap with tin foil so that the shiny side will be **inside** the triangle! If desired, you can put a little hot glue on one end of the triangle before inserting it into your cardboard tube.
4. If desired, wrap tube in construction paper and decorate with markers, stickers, washi tape, etc.
