Paper Plate Weaving

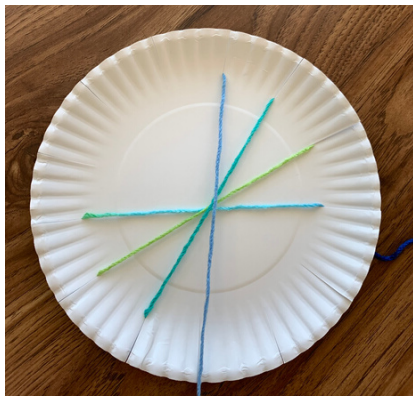
MATERIALS:

- Paper plate
- Yarn
- Popsicle stick
- Scissors

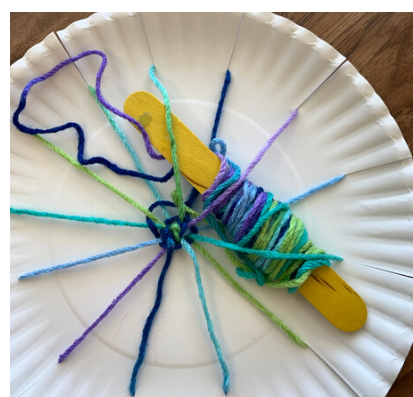


INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut 9 - 11 notches in the edge of your paper plate - **be sure to make an odd number of cuts!**
2. Wrap yarn around the paper plate, threading it through the notches. You want it to be tight enough to stay on, but loose enough to weave through. Tie the end of the yarn to the middle to keep it in place.



3. Wrap a length of yarn around a popsicle stick. Tie one end to the center of the yarn on the plate, and begin weaving, alternating going over and under each strand of yarn on the plate.



3. Continue weaving until you are happy with what you've created. When you're done, snip the yarn on the back side of the plate to release it. You can tie it off to create a little nest, allow the strands to flow loosely to make a jelly fish, etc. Use your imagination!
