Her Home Life was helping with Housework Growing & washing. She helped tend the children.

The Enjoyments in the Home was her Parents and her Brothers and Sisters. They are as follows. Mary Ellen, Margaret, Chris. Henry, Lenora Naomi, then the Twins Joseph Moroni and Henrietta. and Caroline was the Youngest.

She got Married so get out of going to the mountain to Dairy.

She married Herbert Charles Adams April 29, 1890 in the St. George Temple. Her folks had a Big time for them. They went to St. George in a Wagon. Her Cousin Ella Chatterly ^{Mokey} and Mildred Adams (Higbee) went with them to get Married.

The Wood's home is the one we first Started Housekeeping in (it is now over on the Park) our first child Lenora was born there. But other children were born there.
