

JAMES MARSHALL FOWLER

Jane Marshall Fowler daughter of William Marshall and Francis Bridget Kadwall. Born Sep. 15, 1852, Sidney, Australia. Came from Australia to America in 1859. Was on the ocean 19 weeks came to San Barnardino, where her mother died in Feb. 1860. That summer she came to Parowan with her Father. A short time after they arrived her father was called to go with some others to make a settlement at Hocacin, a few miles from Pipe Springs. They were driven out by the Indians and returned to Parowan and made their home.

On the 27th of June, 1870, she married George Fowler in the Endowment House in Salt Lake City. To this marriage there was 5 children born; 3 girls and 2 boys. She died on the 7th of September 1887 at Parowan, lacking 8 days of being 35 years old, with typhoid fever and her youngest girl died 6 weeks later.
