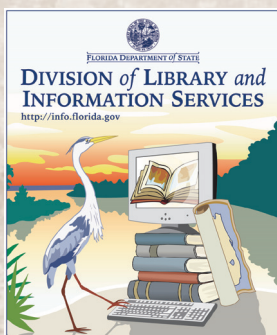
Using proper researching techniques, learn how to investigate historic business records with tips on accessing these archival documents.
