

2022 State of Illinois Tax Rebates

You may be eligible for one-time Income and Property Tax rebates

Must be IL resident and meet income requirements

Individual: AGI under \$400,000 (MFJ)/under \$200,000 (single)

Property Tax: AGI: \$500,000 or less (MFJ)/\$250,000 or less (single)

Individual Income Tax Rebate: \$50.00 per person (\$100.00 per couple for married filing jointly) and \$100.00 per dependent (limit three dependents). Taxpayers who filed their 2021 IL-1040 and qualify do not need to take additional action to receive this rebate.

If you are eligible and did not file an Illinois tax form for 2021, the tax form must be filed by October 17, 2022 to receive this rebate.

Property Tax Rebate: Equal to property tax credit you qualified for on your 2021 IL-1040 tax return up to a maximum of \$300.00. Taxpayers who filed Schedule ICR* with their 2021 IL-1040 and qualify do not need to take additional action to receive this rebate.

If you are eligible and you/your tax preparer did not file 2021 IL-1040 tax form with Schedule ICR*, you have until October 17, 2022 to file form IL-1040-PTR to get your rebate.

**The IL Schedule ICR form calculates a 5% credit for Property Taxes that offsets IL taxes owed. Since many seniors in Illinois do not owe taxes in Illinois, this form is often not completed.*
